| Oppose | Reinstate the recently repealed Don't Ask, Don't Tell policy banning lesbian, gay, and bisexual Americans from openly serving in the armed forces. | Oppose |
| Support | Reauthorize the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) to include protections for all victims. | Support |
| Unknown | Reverse the requirement that insurance plans cover birth control without co- pay or cost-sharing in employee and student health insurance plans. | Oppose |
